ROP classes assist students in bridging the gap between core academics and the real world.

At Harbor High we are fortunate to have several ROP courses that are rigorous and relevant and encourage students to apply what they have learned in the classroom to their future. Some of the courses meet the UC A-G requirement and/or offer college credit, thus providing students a head start in their pursuit of a post-secondary education while still in high school. Students can take a ROP course at Harbor or at an off-campus site as long as the course can fit in the student's class schedule. There are two distinct ROP pathways at Harbor; the following are ROP courses offered at Harbor:

Is your student creative? Does she/he like color and design? Then, Arts, **Media and Entertainment** may be just the pathway to set your student on their career path. ROP Courses in this pathway include:

- Graphic Design 1 & 2 (Meets UC A-G "F" requirement; Cabrillo college credit available)
- Photography (Meets UC A-G "F" requirement)
- Video Production 1 & 2 (Meets UC A-G "F" requirement; Cabrillo college credit available)

Is your student interested in the medical field? Do they like to help injured or sick people? Then, Health, **Science and Medical Technology** may be just the pathway to set your student on their career path. ROP Courses in this pathway include:

- Health Careers
- Medical Technologies (Meets UC A-G "G" requirement)
- Biotechnology (UC A-G "D" in process)
- Sports Related Occupations
- Sports Medicine (UC A-G "D" in process; Cabrillo college credit available)

Other ROP Courses offered at Harbor include:

- Administration of Justice (UC A-G "F" in process; Cabrillo college credit available)
- Bike Performance and Technology
- Business Careers
- Construction Technology (Cabrillo college credit available)
- Integrated Marketing and English (UC A-G "B" requirement)
